

What Is a 401(k) Rollover?

If your employer offers a retirement plan, you might wonder what to do with your 401(k) when you retire or quit. You can consider keeping your retirement funds in your former employer's plan, but this isn't always allowed. Cashing out the 401(k) is another possibility; but depending on your tax situation and age, you may have to deal with taxes and early-withdrawal penalties. One option to bear in mind is moving your funds from the 401(k) to another retirement account. This is known as a "rollover."

Types of Rollovers

401(k) to 401(k). You might consider this type of rollover if you find a new employer that also offers a 401(k) plan. Since it's legal to have multiple 401(k)s, you may be able to keep the old one open while also taking advantage of your new job's retirement plan. However, this is only possible if your previous employer allows former staff to keep their 401(k)s. Regardless, many opt for a rollover because they find it easier to manage their retirement funds in one place. Just remember to check with your new employer to make sure they accept rollovers from past employers.

401 (k) to IRA. Doing a rollover to an individual retirement account (IRA) may be a good option if you're unable to roll over to another 401(k) or you don't like the investment options your new employer offers in their 401(k) plans. You might also roll over to an IRA if you find that it would give you better benefits than a 401(k).

Comparison

Whether you're thinking of rolling your 401(k) over to an IRA or another 401(k), each comes with its advantages and disadvantages. Keeping your funds in a 401(k) could give you a higher contribution limit than an IRA while letting you take advantage of contribution matching from your employer (if they offer it). On the flip side, putting your money into an IRA may be able to offer you a wider range of investment options or lower investment fees.

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- 1. Log into your Home or Mobile Banking account.
